



Queensland Amalgamation Central East Coast Roundtable

Invitation to participate in a roundtable discussion of the Queensland amalgamation, and the process and effects for gallery professionals

In 2007 the Queensland State Government announced plans to amalgamate the 157 Queensland councils operating within Queensland into 73 super councils. This State Government plan was to be undertaken within the year, and the official date for amalgamation was set for the 14th of March 2008. Within that year a considerable amount of consultations and planning has been undertaken for the newly forming councils to be operational by the 14th of March 2008.

This roundtable brings together professionals of the gallery sector of the central east coast of Queensland, to provide an opportunity to review, consider and discuss the process and outcomes that have been undertaken both pre and post amalgamation and the effect it will have on the gallery sector.

The round table is scheduled for the 20th of March 2008 with the support of the Bundaberg Arts Centre, Bundaberg City Council; Pacific Asia Observatory for Cultural Diversity in Human Development (UNESCO); and the Museum Studies program at the University of Queensland.

This round table will provide an opportunity for regional gallery directors and/ or immediate supervisors to put forward 20 minute case studies of their gallery's experience with the amalgamation process. This opportunity will enable a total of 4 case studies with a open discussion at the end of the day to reflect on the issues raised.
